OLD BUSINESS: We are still seeking one parent representative from Newbury.

NEW BUSINESS: Parents are being sought to serve on the interview panel for the selection of the new Triton High Principal. Representatives from each of the three Triton towns were requested. Two Rowley & one Salisbury parent have stepped forward; volunteers are still being sought from Newbury. Contact Beth DiMento at dimento@verizon.net if interested. Ms. Dawe gave an update on the budget process. The budget will be presented to the School Committee on January 15, 2019 at 6:00 PM. Level funding is expected. The High School is asking for a FT Science teacher in addition to the District-wide Technology package. Late buses are still on the wish list. Ms. Dawe also detailed an Anti-vaping campaign that will begin after the New Year. Discussion surrounded ways parents and others can help with the initiative. The NEASC self-reflection report is underway, based on survey results. Two staff members are working on each of the five NEASC standards. The self-reflection report seems to be meshing with the new School Improvement Plan, which is currently being developed. Presentations will be made at future School Council meetings with the final report completed at the end of the school year or in September 2019. NEASC will visit in the fall of 2019.

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN: Work continued on the School Improvement Plan (SIP) with the formation of a rough draft of Goal #4 (Ensure that THS has the budgetary resources necessary to meet the needs of all students). Development of the SIP will be an on-going project and is expected to be completed in several months. The “working document” draft is available as a Google doc to all Council members for their review and input. Progress on developing the new SIP will continue in future meetings.
